



CAMPGROUND RULES in a NUTSHELL

(Also Known as Appendix "B")

Please read and follow the rules of the Campground.

Thank you for making Holiday Harbour a wonderful camping experience for everyone.

1. The rules and regulations are in place to keep you safe and enhance the camping experience.
2. Household garbage is to be placed – by you – in the dumpster provided next to the dumping station at the front of the park. Household garbage is considered anything that would attract wildlife or cause odor on, or around your site.
3. Recycling is offered as a service to our campers. We ask that you rinse out your food recycling before putting it in the blue bin, and refrain from placing anything other than recyclables in the blue bins (this includes plastic bags as they are not recyclable).
4. Children: Their conduct and safety are the total responsibility of their parents. All children are to be on their campsite by 10:00 pm. **PLEASE!! No riding of bicycles after dark or cutting through sites.** Children under 12 must be supervised by an adult (over 19) when on the beach. Children under the age of 11 should be under adult supervision at all times. Rules enforced outside of the park are also in effect within the park, such as **helmets for bikes riders.** Parents – please help us keep your children safe by knowing where your children are.
5. Check-ins is at 2:00 pm and check-out is 12:00 pm for overnight campers (2:00 pm & 11:00 am for the rental unit)
6. Tents on sites are by manager permission only. Please advise at time of reservation or check in if tents will be used during your stay.
7. **ALL** Guest and Visitors must register at the office. In the event of an emergency we need to know who is in the park at all times.
8. Please be respectful of the park, its contents and your neighbor's belongings.
9. PETS – Limit 2 pets per camp site. All pets need to be leashed and aggressive breeds of dogs including Pit Bull and Rottweiler's are not allowed in the park. Pets are not allowed on the beach, playground or in any park building.
10. SPEED KILLS or severely injuries – DRIVE **anything SLOW!** **The speed limit is 10 km/hr.** You may have to drive with your brakes on, and that's OK. Repeat offenders will be asked to leave the park.
11. QUIET time: 11:00 pm – 9:00 am. This is strictly enforced. Thank you for your cooperation in keeping this a quiet family-oriented park.
12. Alcohol – Be discrete & obey the Laws of the Province.
13. FIRES – be SAFE for EVERYONE! (at times, restrictions may apply). Never leave a campfire unattended and put it completely out before you go to sleep at night.
